



Facility Safety Rules are established to protect the operators from identified hazards at the Nezperce Operations. All workers are expected to abide by these rules and work in a manner that prevents injury and other unanticipated safety events. Violation of any of these rules may be cause for immediate disciplinary action, up to and including termination.

General

Smoking allowed within designated areas only

Report unsafe conditions to your immediate manager or foreman.

DOT vehicles and forklifts must be inspected daily. Do not operate any vehicles or equipment you feel is unsafe. Report any unsafe conditions with vehicles or equipment to your supervisor immediately.

Dry Fertilizer

Never operate any machine unless all guards and safety devices are in place and in proper operating condition. If a guard or safety device is removed for maintenance or inspection, it shall be replaced before operating the machine again.

The dry fertilizer mixer hopper is a confined space by OSHA definition. All applicable lockout/tagout and confined space requirements shall be adhered to prior to entry into the hopper.

Liquid Fertilizer Area

All workers shall wear chemical protective gloves, coveralls and goggles during anhydrous ammonia, aqua or other chemical transfer operations where chemical contact is possible

All spills, leaks or uncontrolled releases must be promptly contained to avoid exposure to persons or the environment. Report release incidents to Management immediately

All pesticide and herbicide containers must be triple-rinsed prior to being placed in the containment area.

Ensure that access to emergency eyewash; showers and submersion tanks are unobstructed at all times. Inspect portable eyewash stations every quarter to ensure that device contains ample fluid and has been treated.

Vehicle operators shall wear seat belts or other operator restraint devices as provided on all vehicles

Chemical Shed

Required levels of personal protective equipment (PPE) shall be worn when handling or transferring chemicals and potential for splash is present. (Chemical splash not probable during packaged cases of chemicals)

All procedures pertaining to Roundup Repack shall be adhered to at all times.

All emergency response equipment (emergency showers, eyewash stations, etc.) shall be in place and in "ready" condition during chemical transfers

All chemical spills (dry or liquid) shall be cleaned up immediately
